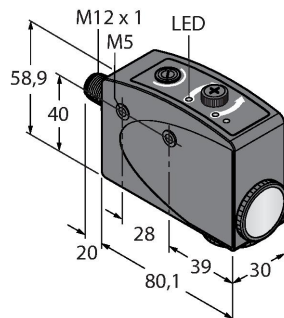

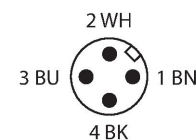
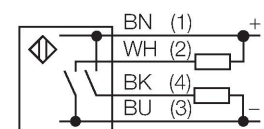

Functional principle

The color mark sensor differentiates between all conventional color contrasts occurring in product and material registration. For this purpose it uses red light. The very short response time of 50 µs is ideally suited for high speed applications. The sensor's switchpoint is adjusted in 15 steps via potentiometer. Via rotary switch, the sensor can also be taught to differentiate between ON and OFF state.
